ReClam The Bay grows millions of baby clams and oysters to help our volunteers explain the benefits of shellfish filtering, feeding and cleaning the estuary. The activities and locations listed below are part of a fun, educational *treasure hunt* where you will learn the heritage and ecology of Barnegat Bay. The award winning Clam trail takes you to points of interest all around Barnegat Bay as part of a game where you earn points to win awards! (See *Playing the Game* for details) **Numbered green type denotes Eco-Friendly Fun Activity.**

#### Playing The Game

The activities and locations are part of a fun, educational treasure hunt where you will learn the heritage and ecology of Barnegat Bay. The award-winning Clam Trail takes you to places of interest all around Barnegat Bay. The game is to earn points to win awards! You can decide on the part of the trail that is of most interest to you. Explore for a day, week or the entire year. Even if you only visit a few locations PLEASE register. This helps us monitor the program.

The goal is to score points by visiting locations on the Clam Trail. You will use your *EXPLORER LOG* (below) to record the information found on a **Fact Plaque** at each location (Example: Fact #...**16**, Location...**4**, Bold word... **Filter**).

**NOTE:** Exploring is not always easy! Some addresses are general and the Fact Plaque may require some searching. Have fun and EXPLORE! Please report problems! Some Fact Plaques may be missing. If you can't find a Fact Plaque, enter the name of the Location in the "Bold Word" space and enter "Missing" across the "Location #" and "Fact #" spaces.

#### There are 3 ways to Register:

1. Fill in the Explorer Log below, detach it from the map, fold it and use it as a self mailer (address is on the reverse side, be sure to affix proper postage)
2. Fax the completed Explorer Log to 732-505-8941.
3. Record the information on the Log and then enter it online at [www.reclamthebay.org](http://www.reclamthebay.org).

- **40 points** you will receive the certificate and the special 'Sam the Clam' stickers
- **100 points** you will receive a beautiful pewter metal clam or oyster pin.

The letters following the location on the listing tell the kind of place and the legend below tells the number of points earned by visiting., **PI** = Place of Interest (3 points), **CF** = Clam Friends (3 points), **UP** = Upweller - Shellfish Nursery (5 points), **GC** = Giant Clam (7 points)
